Originally known as ANU E Press, the Press was established in 2003 to explore the options offered by emerging epublishing technology for The Australian National University's academic output. At the beginning of 2014, ANU E Press became ANU Press and, at present, our small, committed team has published over 750 titles as ebooks and Print-on-Demand (PoD) books.

Electronic publishing has many advantages over traditional publishing methods: it's inexpensive and rapid, which is particularly valuable in the dissemination of new research and academic exploration. Lowered production costs reduce the pressure to recoup expenses through profits, which allows ANU Press to:

- > give voice to researchers whose work is excellent but may lack a significant commercial audience
- > demolish barriers to entry for developing fields of research that might struggle against traditional, risk-averse publication models
- > publish texts that deal with contemporary issues and breaking research at the height of relevance and public interest
- maximise the clarity and impact of research data by using meaningful photos, images and graphs without increasing the cost of production.

In keeping with the strategic goals of The Australian National University, our focus is on contributing to global research, teaching and learning. To that end, all ANU Press publications are made freely available through our website in a variety of electronic formats to encourage greater dissemination and uptake. Students and researchers can either download or read online any of ANU Press' texts immediately, from anywhere in the world.

Electronic publishing has other advantages for readers. Ebooks:

- make searching text easy, a huge benefit for researchers and students mining diverse tomes for specific information

Information for authors

A comprehensive explanation of ANU Press publishing processes is available on our website (press.anu.edu.au/ author-resources), but here's a brief overview.

ANU Press refers all proposals to the relevant editorial board for evaluation. Once the board is satisfied a manuscript is suitable for publication, they arrange for it to be peer reviewed (a minimum of two double-blind reports, with at least one sourced from outside ANU). Manuscripts are then professionally copyedited and styled before production begins.

Depending on the manuscript, production takes about three to four months. At the end of the process, the book is published on the ANU Press website and is available to read online, download as an ebook free of charge or purchase in PoD. We also register your book in a range of databases to make sure it is distributed as widely as possible.






Where in the world are ANU Press readers?







For reasons of effectiveness, efficiency and equity, Australian law reform should be planned carefully. Academics can and should take the lead in this process. This book collects over 50 discrete law reform recommendations, encapsulated in short, digestible essays written by leading Australian scholars. It emerges from a major conference held at The Australian National University in 2016, which featured intensive discussion among participants from government, practice and the academy. The book is intended to serve as a national focal point for Australian legal innovation. It is divided into six main parts: commercial and corporate law, criminal law and evidence, environmental law, private law, public law, and legal practice and legal education. In addition, Indigenous perspectives on law reform are embedded throughout each part. This collective work—the first of its kind—will be of value to policy makers, media, law reform agencies, academics, practitioners and the judiciary. It provides a bird's eye view of the current state and the future of law reform in Australia.

Academic lawyers in Australia have long played a vital role in the national project of law reform. They thought about it; they wrote about it; they worried about its haphazard ways; and they taught their students, and others who would listen, about the need for a more systematic and effective approach to the challenge.



Grappling with the Bomb is a history of Britain's 1950s program to test the hydrogen bomb, code name Operation Grapple. In 1957–58, nine atmospheric nuclear tests were held at Malden Island and Christmas Island—today, part of the Pacific nation of Kiribati. Nearly 14,000 troops travelled to the central Pacific for the UK nuclear testing program—many are still living with the health and environmental consequences.

Based on archival research and interviews with nuclear survivors, Grappling with the Bomb presents i-Kiribati woman Sui Kiritome, British pacifist Harold Steele, businessman James Burns, Fijian sailor Paul Ah Poy, English volunteers Mary and Billie Burgess and first-hand interviews with the ageing survivors who witnessed the British hydrogen bomb tests.

Some historians quibble about the value of personal reminiscences, given the fallibility of memory and our common tendency to exaggeration. But personal testimony and memoir can capture the lived experience of the time and breathe life into the archives. On a topic like nuclear strategy, the bureaucratic language of the written record tends to mute the reality of thermonuclear terror that is the essence of nuclear weaponry.



Learning from Fukushima began as a project to respond in a helpful way to the March 2011 triple disaster (earthquake, tsunami, and nuclear meltdown) in northeastern Japan. It evolved into a collaborative and comprehensive investigation of whether nuclear power was a realistic energy option for East Asia, especially for the 10 member-countries of ASEAN, none of which currently has an operational nuclear power plant.

In this collection, scholars critically investigate the costs and benefits of building nuclear power plants, drawing on comprehensive databases on nuclear power as well as research conducted in the wake of the 2011 Fukushima meltdown. The volume contains separate case studies on Japan, China, South Korea, Taiwan and ASEAN, and the exceptional case of France where almost 75 per cent of electrical power is nuclear. There are detailed examinations of the decommissioning problem, the role of government subsidies, the health implications of exposure to radiation and renewables as an energy alternative.

Learning from Fukushima aims to counter the misinformation, and even disinformation, that sometimes characterise debates about nuclear power, offering an empirically based assessment of the role of nuclear power in East Asia.



Exploring the Earth under the Sea brings to life the world's largest and longest-lived geological research program, which has been drilling over many decades at many locations deep below the ocean floor to recover continuous cores of sediment and rock, Study of these materials has helped us understand how the Earth works now. how it has worked in the past and how it may work in the future. The cores are a wonderful source of information on the dynamic processes that form and reform the Earth, both beneath the ocean and on land. The results have revealed climate and oceanographic change on different time frames, the history of life in the sea and on land including global mass extinctions, the extraordinary story of the great masses of 'extremophile' microbes that live beneath the sea bed, the nature of the giant earthquakes and tsunami generated at the trenches where tectonic plates collide, and the nature of submarine volcanoes and metalliferous deposits.

This book outlines the technology and enduring international partnerships that underlie the scientific ocean drilling accomplished by the first phase of IODP, currently involving 23 countries. It highlights the important role of Australian and New Zealand scientists in the program, and the great scientific benefits we have derived from our partnership since joining IODP in 2008. As well as the scientific summaries, there are personal accounts by shipboard scientists of how they found life at sea on two-month expeditions, working 12-hour shifts on a noisy drill ship.





In Teaching 'Proper' Drinking?, the author brings together three fields of scholarship: socio-historical studies of alcohol, Australian Indigenous policy history and social enterprise studies. The case studies in the book offer the first detailed surveys of efforts to teach responsible drinking practices to Aboriginal people by installing canteens in remote communities, and of the purchase of public hotels by Indigenous groups in attempts both to control sales of alcohol and to create social enterprises by redistributing profits for the community good. Ethnographies of the hotels are examined through the analytical lens of the Swedish 'Gothenburg' system of municipal hotel ownership.

The research reveals that the community governance of such social enterprises is not purely a matter of good administration or compliance with the relevant liquor legislation. Their administration is imbued with the additional challenges posed by political contestation, both within and beyond the communities concerned.

The idea that community or government ownership and management of a hotel or other drinking place would be a good way to control drinking and limit harm has been commonplace in many Anglophone and Nordic countries, but has been less recognised in Australia. Maggie Brady's book brings together the hidden history of such ideas and initiatives in Australia ... In an original and wide-ranging set of case studies, Brady shows that success in reducing harm has varied between communities, largely depending on whether motivations to raise revenue or to reduce harm are in control

A Long Way to Go presents the findings of a unique migration research program harnessing work of some of the leading international and Australian migration researchers on the challenging and complex topic of irregular maritime migration. The book brings together selected findings of the research program, and in doing so it contributes to the ongoing academic and policy discourses by providing findings from rigorous quantitative, qualitative and mixed methods research to support a better understanding of the dynamics of irregular migration and their potential policy implications.

Stemming from the 2012 Expert Panel on Asylum Seekers report, the Irregular Migration Research Program commissioned 26 international research projects involving 17 academic principal researchers, along with private sector specialist researchers, international organisations and policy think tanks. The centrepiece of the research program was a multi-year collaborative partnership between the Department of Immigration and Border Protection and The Australian National University's Crawford School of Public Policy. Under this partnership, empirical research on international irregular migration was commissioned from migration researchers in Australia, Indonesia, Iran, the Netherlands, Sri Lanka and Switzerland.
